This funding will be used to


- Increase the number of students meeting NMS in Literacy and Numeracy to 100%.
- Develop a learning plan for students who are below the National Minimum Standard.
- Increase the percentage of children achieving C+ or better in Literacy and Numeracy from 80% to >85%.
- Improve teacher capability through use of effective pedagogies and an improved feedback culture.

Our initiatives include

- Develop teacher capability in accessing student data and identifying next step for student learning.
- Five weekly data meetings with Principal/teacher to discuss individual student data and identified strategies.
- Embed Pedagogical Framework in every classroom and every lesson.
- Provide teachers time to increase coaching and feedback opportunities in each classroom (Anita Archer).
- Provide time for teachers to review student individual data in Literacy and Numeracy so that individual goals based on specific strategies can be implemented to improve individual student outcome (Anita Archer).

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing 0.2 teacher allowing for opportunities to release teachers for capability building in the area of data monitoring, analysis, intervention and coaching/feedback. **\$21,300**
- Employ Teacher Aide 11 Hours per week to work with targeted students on individual learning plans to improve Literacy and Numeracy. **\$14,250**
- Employ TRS for all teachers to be released for a Planning Day each term to discuss Whole School Data, track students and moderate samples of work. **\$7,145**
